Today the Minnesota Campaign Finance and Public Disclosure Board announced the public preview release of its new website, located at <https://cfb.mn.gov/>

Executive Director Jeff Sigurdson reports that the new site has been under development since September, 2015, and is now operational for regular use as well as for user evaluation and comment.

The Board will maintain its legacy site, at <http://www.cfboard.state.mn.us/> for the next few months as it transitions completely to the new site.

The new website is intended to make it easier for users to find what they are looking for and to provide more comprehensive data than was previously available online. For dedicated followers of campaign finance and lobbying in Minnesota the site offers a user-configurable home page so users can save the links they use most often and easily follow the people or associations they want to monitor more closely.

Presently, data on the new site is updated every night (and multiple times during the day during filing periods). Once the legacy site is closed, data on the new site will be updated in real time or regularly throughout the day.
