The campaign finance report submitted by Ms. Faulson for 2011 shows no change from the 2010 report. Chair Paulson, in an email copied to treasurer Andrew-Paulson, in an email copied to treasurer Andrew-Paulson, in an email copied to treasurer Andrew-Paulson of 847th, however the ma change statement reports a balance of 531.67th. There is avidence suggesting receipt of contributions in March 2011, as well as expenditures suspected and anecdoledly corresponded for 200th to the Midwest leadership conference in October 2011. Inaddition a suspected requested campaign donation to Ms. Paulson's School Board express is not reflected. No meetings were held with a cuorum to approve any expenditures or budget Minn. Stat. 10A.02, subd 11- Violations; enforcement. (See Back)

The board shall investigate any alleged violation filed in writing with the board. For an alleged violation of sections 10A.25 (expenditure limits) or 10A.27 (additional limits) the board shall either enter into a conciliation agreement or make a public finding of whether or not there is probable cause, within 60 days of the filing of the complaint. For alleged violations of all other sections, the board shall within 30 days after the filing of the complaint make a public finding of whether or not there is probable cause to believe a violation has occurred.

The deadline for action may be extended by a majority vote of the board. Within a reasonable time after beginning an investigation of an individual or association, the board shall notify that individual or association of the fact of the investigation. The board shall make no finding without notifying the individual or association of the nature of the allegations and affording an opportunity to answer those allegations.

Any hearing or action of the board concerning a complaint or investigation shall be confidential until the board makes a public finding concerning probable cause or enters into a conciliation agreement.

Except as provided in section 10A.28, after the board makes a public finding of probable cause the board shall report that finding to the appropriate law enforcement authorities.

report, and Ms. Paulson, while in full control of the bank account and check Card along with treasurer Andrew Noble who resigned on 12-22-2011, has refused Executive officers and full committee members of HOGG A RPM any apportunity to review bank statements from TCF upon request or detailed account reports.

In Addition, handling of the campaign finance report and the funds of 4766ARPM have come under further suspicion and scruting because Chair Paulson foiled to notify the Broce officers and delegates of Andrew Noble's resignation from the office of Treasurer until very late January.

Any mal feasance, it is my contention, is not the fault of HDGARPM Full Committee or its 1st Vice-Chair, but solely The Responsibility of Chair Elizabeth tauteon and Creasurer Andrew Mobile, who have had full control and Access to HD66A RPM accounts, funds, and financial statements, made financial decisions independently and without the approval of the HOGGARPM Executive or full Committees, and then filed a campaign finance report which was neither reviewed or appropried by HDGEA RPM and appears to be false or fraudulent. Suther their refusal to cooperate with officers and delegates of HB66A RPM, as is constitutionally required. to resolve the issues and questions, indicates a possible Collusion between Chair Elizabeth Paulson and Treasurer Andrew Noble to file a fall campaign finance report and a refusal to disclose fully and accurately the receipts and expenditures of the organization in a transparent faction as required by the constitution of HDIdott RPM and Minnesota Statute. Campaign finance report to either exonerate Ms. Paulson and Mr. Noble or hold them personally liable for any Campaign sinance violations.
