Minn. Stat. 10A.02, subd 11 - Violations; enforcement.

The board shall investigate any alleged violation filed in writing with the board. For an alleged violation of sections 10A.25 (expenditure limits) or 10A.27 (additional limits) the board shall either enter into a conciliation agreement or make a public finding of whether or not there is probable cause, within 60 days of the filing of the complaint. For alleged violations of all other sections, the board shall within 30 days after the filing of the complaint make a public finding of whether or not there is probable cause to believe a violation has occurred.

The deadline for action may be extended by a majority vote of the board. Within a reasonable time after beginning an investigation of an individual or association, the board shall notify that individual or association of the fact of the investigation. The board shall make no finding without notifying the individual or association of the nature of the allegations and affording an opportunity to answer those allegations.

Any hearing or action of the board concerning a complaint or investigation shall be confidential until the board makes a public finding concerning probable cause or enters into a conciliation agreement.

Except as provided in section 10A.28, after the board makes a public finding of probable cause the board shall report that finding to the appropriate law enforcement authorities.

COMPLAINT FOR VIOLATION OF THE CAMPAIGN FINANCE AND PUBLIC DISCLOSURE ACT

NATURE OF COMPLAINT BY COMPLAINTANT KEVIN VICK

On October 22nd, 2014, Everytown for Gun Safety Minnesota was registered as a Political Committee or Fund with the Minnesota Campaign Finance Board. (Exhibit 1).

On October 24th, 2014, the political committee Public Safety Matters Campaign reported a \$25,000 contribution from the newly registered Everytown for Gun Safety Minnesota via the Campaign Finance Board's 24 Hour Notice Reporting System. (Exhibit 2)

As called for in MN Statute 10A.20, Subd. 5, large campaign contributions exceeding \$1,000 or more must be reported to the Campaign Finance Board within 24 hours via the 24 hour notice reporting system during the timeframe of October 21^{st} – November 3^{rd} .

A review of the 24 Hour Notice Reporting System (Exhibit 3) on Wednesday, October 29th, 2014 showed no report from Everytown for Gun Safety Minnesota as to the source for the \$25,000 donation that was later given to the Public Safety Matters Campaign (Exhibit 3)

Everytown for Gun Safety Minnesota was not required to file a political committee report on October 27th as their registration occurred after the October 20th, 2014 cutoff for this reporting period.

I believe Everytown for Gun Safety Minnesota has failed to file the proper 24 hour report for the source of the \$25,000 donation as their PAC was not formed until October 22nd and no reports have been filed.

The source of their donation has therefore been concealed from the citizens of Minnesota less than two weeks prior to a general election in violation of MN 10A.20, Subd. 5.
