## **CONCILIATION AGREEMENT**

In the Matter of lobbyist Jeanne Massey (2267);

- 1. The Huldah (Momanyi Hiltsley) 4 House committee, the principal campaign committee of Representative Huldah Momanyi Hiltsley, accepted a \$250 contribution from lobbyist Jeanne Massey on April 6, 2024, during a regular session of the legislature. Minnesota Statutes section 10A.273, subdivision 1, prohibits a registered lobbyist from making a contribution to a candidate for legislative or constitutional office during a regular session of the legislature.
- 2. Ms. Massey stated that she didn't think that the legislative prohibition applied to her contribution because at the time the candidate was not in the legislature. Ms. Massey states that she discovered her error but the contribution was not returned within 90 days of deposit and is therefore deemed accepted under Minnesota Statutes section 10A.15, subdivision 3. The contribution was refunded by the Momanyi Hiltsley committee in July 2025.
- 3. The parties agree that Ms. Massey contributed to a candidate during a regular session of the legislature in violation of Minnesota Statutes section 10A.273, subdivision 1. Ms. Massey has been a registered lobbyist since 2009, and this is her first violation of the restrictions on contributions during the legislative session.
- 4. To avoid a similar violation in the future, Ms. Massey agrees that she will not make a contribution during a regular legislative session to any candidate for the legislature or for constitutional office, or to any legislative party unit. Ms. Massey will ensure that any contribution made to a candidate is accompanied by her Board registration number as required by Minnesota Statutes section 10A.15, subdivision 5.
- 5. Ms. Massey agrees to the imposition of a civil penalty of \$100 for making a contribution prohibited by Minnesota Statutes section 10A.273, subdivision 1. The amount of the civil penalty was determined in part by the fact that this was a first-time violation.
