CONCILIATION AGREEMENT

In the matter of the Xp Lee for MN House committee (19223);

- 1. Xp Lee for MN House is the principal campaign committee of Representative Lee. The candidate filed a public subsidy agreement with the Board on July 16, 2025, covering the 2025 special election segment for Minnesota House District 34B and subjecting the committee to a spending limit over that same period. The base spending limit for a candidate for House of Representatives was \$80,300.
- 2. On its 2025 special election cycle final report of receipts and expenditures the committee reported that it had made \$82,098.03 in total campaign expenditures during the special election cycle. Because noncampaign disbursements do not count against the spending limit, Board staff reviewed the report and determined that the committee reported its campaign expenditures and noncampaign disbursements correctly in the 2025 special election. Therefore, the committee exceeded the special election cycle spending limit by \$1,798.03.
- 3. Board records show that this is the first instance in which the committee reported campaign expenditures that exceeded the spending limit. The committee registered with the Board on July 16, 2025. The committee self-reported the violation to Board staff after discovering the issue.
- 4. The parties agree that the committee inadvertently made excessive campaign expenditures in violation of Minnesota Statutes section 10A.25, subdivision 2, during the 2025 special election segment for House District 34B.
- 5. The candidate agrees to the imposition of a civil penalty in the amount of \$1,798.03, one times the amount by which the committee exceeded the spending limit for the 2025 special election segment. The penalty must be paid within 30 days of the date the agreement is signed by both parties.
- 6. It is further understood and agreed that if the candidate does not comply with the provisions of this agreement, this matter may be reopened by the Board and the Board may take such actions as it deems appropriate.
