



## 2020 Disclosure Calendar for Candidates not Filing for Office in 2020

Minnesota Campaign Finance and Public Disclosure Board

**Please Note:** This calendar does not apply to candidates who will file to appear on the ballot in 2020. If you have an appellate court candidate committee, please use the 2020 Disclosure Calendar for Appellate Court Candidates.

### 2020

January 31	<b>2019 year-end report of receipts and expenditures due.</b> Period covered: 1/1/2019 through 12/31/2019.
February 3	\$25 per day late filing fee begins for failure to file the year-end report of receipts and expenditures.
February 11 through May 18	Legislative session. Candidates may not accept or solicit contributions from political committees, political funds, lobbyists, or unregistered associations. This prohibition applies to incumbent and non-incumbent candidates, but does not apply to judicial and special election candidates.

### 2021

February 1	<b>2020 year-end report of receipts and expenditures due.</b> Period covered: 1/1/2020 through 12/31/2020.
February 2	\$25 per day late filing fee begins for failure to file the year-end report of receipts and expenditures.
