January 31	2019 year-end report of receipts and expenditures due. Period covered: 1/1/2019 through 12/31/2019.
February 3	\$25 per day late filing fee begins for failure to file the year-end report of receipts and expenditures.
February 11 through May 18	Legislative session. Party units may not accept or solicit contributions from a lobbyist, political committee or fund, or party unit, at an event hosted by a legislative or constitutional office candidate during the regular legislative session.
July 20	Last day of transactions included in the pre-primary report of receipts and expenditures.
July 27	Pre-primary report of receipts and expenditures due. Period covered: 1/1/2020 through 7/20/2020.
July 28	\$50 per day late filing fee begins for failure to file the pre-primary report of receipts and expenditures.
August 11	PRIMARY ELECTION
October 19	Last day of transactions included in the pre-general report of receipts and expenditures.
October 26	Pre-general report of receipts and expenditures due. Period covered: 1/1/2020 through 10/19/2020.
October 27	\$50 per day late filing fee begins for failure to file the pre-general report of receipts and expenditures.
November 3	GENERAL ELECTION

February 1	2020 year-end report of receipts and expenditures due. Period covered: 1/1/2020 through 12/31/2020.
February 2	\$25 per day late filing fee begins for failure to file the year-end report of receipts and expenditures.
