



## 2022 Disclosure Calendar for Candidates not Filing for Office in 2022

Minnesota Campaign Finance and Public Disclosure Board

**Please Note:** This calendar does not apply to candidates who will file to appear on the ballot in 2022. If you have an appellate court candidate committee, please use the 2022 Disclosure Calendar for Appellate Court Candidates.

### 2022

- January 31 **2021 year-end report of receipts and expenditures due.** Period covered: 1/1/2021 through 12/31/2021.
- February 1 \$25 per day late filing fee begins for failure to file the year-end report of receipts and expenditures.
- January 31 through May 23 Legislative session. Candidates may not accept or solicit contributions from political committees, political funds, lobbyists, or unregistered associations. This prohibition applies to incumbent and non-incumbent candidates, but does not apply to judicial and special election candidates.

### 2023

- January 31 **2022 year-end report of receipts and expenditures due.** Period covered: 1/1/2022 through 12/31/2022.
- February 1 \$25 per day late filing fee begins for failure to file the year-end report of receipts and expenditures.
