

2023 Campaign Finance Disclosure Calendar

2023

January 1 First date to sign and file public subsidy agreements for the 2023-2024 election cycle. A new public subsidy agreement must be signed and filed with the Board before a political contribution receipt can be issued for a contribution received in 2023.

January 3 Legislative session. Candidate committees and legislative caucuses may not accept through contributions from political committees, political funds, unregistered associations, or May 22 lobbyists from January 3, 2023, until the session is adjourned.

The prohibition applies to <u>all registered candidates</u> except *judicial* and *special election* candidates. Contributions from individuals who are not lobbyists and from political party units are acceptable.

- January 31 2022 year-end report of receipts and expenditures due. Period covered: 1/1/2022 through 12/31/2022.
- February 1 \$25 per day late filing fee begins for failure to file the 2022 year-end report of receipts and expenditures.

2024

- January 31 2023 year-end report of receipts and expenditures due. Period covered: 1/1/2023 through 12/31/2023.
- February 1 \$25 per day late filing fee begins for failure to file the 2023 year-end report of receipts and expenditures.
