

Minnesota Campaign Finance and Public Disclosure Board

2023

- September 13 Candidate filing period opens to run for office. **Candidates must file a statement of economic** interest within 14 days after filing for office.
- September 19 Last day for candidates to file to run for office.
- September 20 Last day for candidates to sign and file a public subsidy agreement.
- September 25 Last day to raise contributions to qualify for public subsidy and to file an affidavit of contributions.
- November 2 Last day of transactions included in the pre-special primary report of receipts and expenditures.

November 3 Reporting of Large Contributions – Pre-special primary

- through Contributions and loans from any one source totaling more than \$500 must be reported to the
 November 15 Board electronically or in person by the end of the next business day after receipt and also on subsequent reports of receipts and expenditures for the special election cycle. Failure to file the notice on time will result in a \$50 per day late filing fee. Note: Candidates who are unopposed at the special primary do not need to report large contributions during this period.
- November 9 **Pre-special primary report of receipts and expenditures due (if there is a special primary).** Period covered: January 1 through November 2, 2023.
- November 13 \$50 per day late filing fee begins for failure to file the pre-special primary report of receipts and expenditures.
- November 16 SPECIAL PRIMARY
- November 21 Last day of transactions included in the pre-special election report of receipts and expenditures.

November 22 Reporting of Large Contributions – Pre-special election

- through Contributions and loans from any one source totaling more than \$500 must be reported to the
 December 4 Board electronically or in person by the end of the next business day after receipt and also on subsequent reports of receipts and expenditures for the special election cycle. Failure to file the notice on time will result in a \$50 per day late filing fee. Note: Candidates who lost the special primary do not need to report large contributions during this period.
- November 28 **Pre-special election report of receipts and expenditures due.** Period covered: January 1 through November 21, 2023.

- November 29 \$50 per day late filing fee begins for failure to file the pre-special election report of receipts and expenditures.
- November 30 Public subsidy payment distributed to eligible candidates not later than one week after the canvassing board certification of the special primary.
- December 5 SPECIAL ELECTION
- December 20 Public subsidy agreements expire.

2024

- January 2 **Special election cycle final report of receipts and expenditures due.** Period covered: January 1 through December 20, 2023. **Note:** Candidates will be required to file a 2023 yearend report in addition to the special election cycle final report, unless the special election cycle final report is a termination report.
- January 3 \$25 per day late filing fee begins for failure to file the special election cycle final report of receipts and expenditures.
- January 31 2023 year-end report of receipts and expenditures due. Period covered: January 1 through December 31, 2023. **Note:** This report is not required if the special election cycle final report was a termination report with an ending balance of \$100 or less.
- February 1 \$25 per day late filing fee begins for failure to file the 2023 year-end report of receipts and expenditures.
