



Senate District 45 Special Election Public Disclosure Calendar

- June 7 First day for candidates to sign and file a public subsidy agreement.
- June 10 Candidate filing period opens to run for office. **Candidates must file a statement of economic interest within 14 days after filing for office.**
- June 11 Last day for candidates to file to run for office. Must file by 5 p.m.
- June 12 Last day for candidates to sign and file a public subsidy agreement.
- June 17 Last day to raise contributions and file an affidavit of contributions to qualify for public subsidy.
- July 30 Last day of transactions to be included in the pre-special primary report of receipts and expenditures.
- July 31 through August 12 **Reporting of Large Contributions – Pre-special primary**
Contributions and loans from any one source totaling more than \$500 must be reported to the Board electronically or in person by the end of the next business day after receipt and also on subsequent reports of receipts and expenditures for the special election cycle. Failure to file the notice on time will result in a \$50 per day late filing fee. **Note:** Candidates who are unopposed at the special primary do not need to report large contributions during this period.
- August 6 **Pre-special primary report of receipts and expenditures due (if there is a special primary).** Period covered: January 1 through July 30, 2024.
- August 7 \$50 per day late filing fee begins for failure to file the pre-special primary report of receipts and expenditures.
- August 13 **PRIMARY ELECTION** (if necessary)
- October 22 Last day of transactions to be included in the pre-special election report of receipts and expenditures.
- October 23 through November 4 **Reporting of Large Contributions – Pre-special election**
Contributions and loans from any one source totaling more than \$500 must be reported to the Board electronically or in person by the end of the next business day after receipt and also on subsequent reports of receipts and expenditures for the special election cycle. Failure to file the notice on time will result in a \$50 per day late

filing fee. **Note:** Candidates who lost the special primary do not need to report large contributions during this period.

- October 29 **Pre-special election report of receipts and expenditures due.** Period covered: January 1 through October 22, 2024.
- November 5 **SPECIAL ELECTION**
- November 20 Public subsidy agreements expire for special election cycle.
- November 21 New Public Subsidy agreements may be signed.
- November 25 Last day of transactions to be included in the special election cycle-end report of receipts and expenditures.
- December 2 **Special election cycle final report of receipts and expenditures due.** Period covered: January 1 through November 25, 2024. **Note:** Candidates will be required to file a 2024 year-end report in addition to the special election cycle final report unless the special election cycle final report is a termination report.
- December 3 \$50 per day late filing fee begins for failure to file the special election cycle-end report of receipts and expenditures.
