



2026 Disclosure Calendar for Candidates Not Running For Office

Please Note: This calendar does not apply to legislative or district court candidates who will file to appear on the ballot in 2026 or to constitutional or appellate court candidates whose seat will be on the ballot in 2026. If you have a legislative or district court candidate committee AND you are filing for office, please use the 2026 Disclosure Calendar for Candidates for Senate, House, and District Courts. If you have a constitutional or appellate court candidate committee AND your office or seat will be on the ballot in 2026, please use the 2026 Disclosure Calendar for Candidates for Constitutional Offices and Appellate Courts.

2026

- February 2 **2025 year-end report of receipts and expenditures due.** Period covered: 1/1/2025 through 12/31/2025.
- February 3 \$25 per day late filing fee begins for failure to file the year-end report of receipts and expenditures.
- February 17 through May 18 Legislative session. Candidates may not accept or solicit contributions from political committees, political funds, lobbyists, or unregistered associations during the regular legislative session. This prohibition applies to incumbent and non-incumbent legislative and constitutional office candidates, but does not apply to judicial or special election candidates.

2027

- February 1 **2026 year-end report of receipts and expenditures due.** Period covered: 1/1/2026 through 12/31/2026.
- February 2 \$25 per day late filing fee begins for failure to file the year-end report of receipts and expenditures.
