2026

- February 2 **2025 year-end report of receipts and expenditures due.** Period covered: 1/1/2025 through 12/31/2025.
- February 3 \$25 per day late filing fee begins for failure to file the year-end report of receipts and expenditures.
- February 17 through May 18 Legislative session. A party unit may not accept or solicit contributions from a lobbyist, political committee, political fund, or party unit at an event hosted by a legislative or constitutional office candidate during the regular legislative session. This prohibition applies to events hosted by incumbent and non-incumbent legislative and constitutional office candidates, but does not apply to events hosted by judicial or local candidates.
- July 20 Last day of transactions included in the pre-primary report of receipts and expenditures.
- July 27 **Pre-primary-election of receipts and expenditures due.** Period covered: 1/1/2026 through 7/20/2026.
- July 28 \$50 per day late filing fee begins for failure to file the pre-primary report of receipts and expenditures.
- August 11 PRIMARY ELECTION
- October 19 Last day of transactions included in the pre-general report of receipts and expenditures.
- October 26 **Pre-general report of receipts and expenditures due.** Period covered: 1/1/2026 through 10/19/2026.
- October 27 \$50 per day late filing fee begins for failure to file the pre-general report of receipts and expenditures.
- November 3 GENERAL ELECTION

2027

- February 1 **2026 year-end report of receipts and expenditures due.** Period covered: 1/1/2026 through 12/31/2026.
- February 2 \$25 per day late filing fee begins for failure to file the year-end report of receipts and expenditures.
