February 17

Legislative session. A party unit may not accept or solicit contributions from a lobbyist, through May 18

political committee, political fund, or party unit at an event hosted by a legislative or constitutional office candidate during the regular legislative session. This prohibition applies to events hosted by incumbent and non-incumbent legislative and constitutional office candidates, but does not apply to events hosted by judicial or local candidates.

July 20 Last day of transactions included in the pre-primary report of receipts and expenditures.

July 27 **Pre-primary-election of receipts and expenditures due.** Period covered: 1/1/2026

through 7/20/2026.

\$50 per day late filing fee begins for failure to file the pre-primary report of receipts and July 28

expenditures.

August 11 PRIMARY ELECTION

October 19 Last day of transactions included in the pre-general report of receipts and expenditures.

October 26 Pre-general report of receipts and expenditures due. Period covered: 1/1/2026 through

10/19/2026.

October 27 \$50 per day late filing fee begins for failure to file the pre-general report of receipts and

expenditures.

November 3 **GENERAL ELECTION**

2027

February 1 2026 year-end report of receipts and expenditures due. Period covered: 1/1/2026 through

12/31/2026.

February 2 \$25 per day late filing fee begins for failure to file the year-end report of receipts and

expenditures.
