



2024 Disclosure Calendar for Candidates not Filing for Office in 2024

Minnesota Campaign Finance and Public Disclosure Board

Please Note: This calendar does not apply to house of representative or district court candidates who will file to appear on the ballot in 2024 or to appellate court candidates whose seat will be on the ballot in 2024. If you have a house of representatives or district court candidate committee AND you are filing for office, please use the 2024 Disclosure Calendar for House and District Court Candidates. If you have an appellate court candidate committee AND your seat will be on the ballot in 2024, please use the 2024 Disclosure Calendar for Appellate Court Candidates.

2024

- January 31 **2023 year-end report of receipts and expenditures due.** Period covered: 1/1/2023 through 12/31/2023.
- February 1 \$25 per day late filing fee begins for failure to file the year-end report of receipts and expenditures.
- February 12 through May 20 Legislative session. Candidates may not accept or solicit contributions from political committees, political funds, lobbyists, or unregistered associations. This prohibition applies to incumbent and non-incumbent candidates, but does not apply to judicial and special election candidates.

2025

- January 31 **2024 year-end report of receipts and expenditures due.** Period covered: 1/1/2024 through 12/31/2024.
- February 3 \$25 per day late filing fee begins for failure to file the year-end report of receipts and expenditures.
