Adoption of Rules Relating to Campaign Finance; Minnesota Rules, part 4503.0900; Revisor's ID Number 4982; CAH Docket Number 5-9030-41329

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

- 1. The Campaign Finance and Public Disclosure Board has complied with all notice and procedural requirements in Minnesota Statutes, chapter 14, Minnesota Rules, chapter 1400, and other applicable law.
 - 2. The Court of Administrative Hearings received 0 written comments on the rules.
- 3. By Laws of Minnesota 2025, chapter 39, article 7, section 22, the Minnesota Legislature requires the Board to make the following rule changes:
 - A. Amend Minnesota Rules, part 4503.0900, subpart 1, by deleting Item F; and
 - B. Amend Minnesota Rules, part 4503.0900, subpart 2c, by changing the cross-reference in Item D to refer to Minnesota Statutes, section 10A.174, rather than Minnesota Rules, part 4503.0900, subpart 1.
- 4. The use of the good cause exempt rulemaking process for these rules is authorized by Laws of Minnesota 2025, chapter 39, article 7, section 22. According to Minnesota Statutes, section 14.388, subdivision 1, clause (3), these changes incorporate specific changes stated in applicable statutes that require no interpretation of law.
 - 5. The rules are needed and reasonable.
